The collection of the SSN is **mandatory**, and is collected under authority of N.J.S.A. 54:50-24 et seq. and Administrative Rule N.J.A.C. 5:3-1.2. - d. Provide a <u>letter from your fire department</u> verifying your structural firefighter experience. The applicant must have been a member of a fire department who has been qualified and performed as a "structural firefighter" for at least three years prior to application. Proof of structural firefighter experience shall be verified in writing by the chief of department or training officer on fire department letterhead. *Note: Experience as a junior firefighter shall not count for structural firefighter verification.*

- a. Attach a photocopy of your **Incident Management Level 1 Certification**; and
- b. Provide a copy of your Intermediate Incident Management System I-300 course completion certificate. You must have satisfactorily completed a classroom instructor-led program of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) course titled "I-300 Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents."

Level 3

- a. Attach a photocopy of your Incident Management Level 2 Certification; and
- b. Provide a copy of your <u>Advanced Incident Management System I-400</u> course completion certificate. You must have satisfactorily completed a classroom instructor-led program of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) course titled "I-400 Advanced ICS for Command and General Staff."
